## **NEW SCHOOL YEAR – NEW ENROLMENTS**

We will welcome a new class of Junior Infants at the start of the next school year (2016- 2017). We are now preparing everything for their arrival.

Completed enrolment forms must be returned to the school as soon as possible. Decisions in relation to enrolment are made by the Board of Management in accordance with school policy. As a general principle children will be enrolled on application provided there are places available. In the event that applications for enrolment exceed or is expected to exceed the number of places available the following decision making process will apply. The Board will exercise its discretion in the application of the following criteria:

- Whether there are siblings of the proposed new entrant already in the school
- Ages of the children: the school policy recommends that the child be four years of age before April 1<sup>st</sup> of the year of application for enrolment

· Parish boundaries/ Diocesan policies

Copies of the Enrolment Policy are available in the office and parents are welcome to request one.

## **NOTES FOR ABSENCES**

When a child is absent from school, parents must sent a note to the teacher to explain the reason for the child's absence. Parents may like to fill in the notes at the back of the journal or write their own note if they prefer. It is really important that the <u>reason</u> for the absence is given for example illness etc... Schools must collect this information and if a child is absent for twenty days or more in any school year the school must report this information to TUSLA (The Child and Family Agency) and must give details of the reason for the absences. If parents send in a note that the child was absent on eg January 9<sup>th</sup> and do not give a reason the school must record that as an unexplained absence.

# VOLUNTEERS

We are very lucky to have so many parents who are always willing to help out at short notice. This week we have two teams of volunteers – the parents helping with swimming supervision and also our emergency weather team. The swimming could not go ahead without the volunteers and we say a very special thank you to those who volunteer. We also realise and understand fully that some parents cannot help out because of their commitments.

The second team of volunteers this week is our emergency weather team. They do a wonderful job in helping to keep the entrances and main parts of the yards frost free. Thankfully we haven't had to avail of their services yet this winter.

# **FIRST PENANCE**

The children in second class are preparing for their First Penance and also for First Communion. As part of the preparations there are a number of children's Masses- the next one is January 31<sup>st</sup>. The First Penance will be held on March 12<sup>th</sup> 2016.

#### **CATHOLIC SCHOOLS WEEK**

Each year the last week in January is the week when Catholic Schools Week is celebrated. We know that Jesus is the face of God's mercy. It is he who allows us to see how merciful the Father is. When we see how Jesus is with people whom others condemn and reject, we begin to glimpse the mercy of God.
