School Reminders:

-Please note school starts at 9:15am so to ensure children are dropped off at 9:10am and are on time for class.

-We remind you all to label your child/ren's uniforms. Already we have started a collection of uniforms with no names and no one coming into claim. We know that uniforms are expensive so it is so important that your child has these in with them daily and going home daily too.

Also, with the colder weather setting in, we are reminding all students to bring in daily a coat with hood or a hat (scarves and gloves) to keep warm on yard. Please ensure tags on coats are labelled too.

-Our Fresh Today Morning Snacks and Hot Foods are proving to be a big hit here this year which is great to see. There is so much choice available for the children to choose from and it's lovely to see the children having something warm especially on the colder days. Just a gentle reminder that if you want to make any changes to your child/rens menu to make sure these are made using your logins before 5pm each Thursday.

As per the announcement in June last year, water will no longer be provided with the Fresh Today lunches so it is vital that all students have a minimum of 1 litre in with them each day. The senior students are advised to have between 1-2 litres with them especially on days if they are having PE or Sporting events.
